Dear parent/carer,

As the end of the academic year is rapidly approaching, I would like to make you aware of a number of key pieces of information.

Firstly, you may already be aware that we will be beginning our new timetable on Monday 2nd July, meaning that your child will be promoted to the next academic year for the last three weeks of term. This gives them a fantastic head start on their next year of learning, which is particularly critical for our current year 10 students, who will begin their year 11 studies before the summer holiday.

There are also a number of reminders about our academy uniform that I would like to reinforce to you:

- Trousers for boys and girls need to be tailored with a crease at the front.
- Socks should be black or grey – this is a change to our current uniform policy which allows white socks. From Monday 2nd July onwards, this will no longer be acceptable.
- Coats should be dark blue, grey or black in colour, and hoodies are not allowed.
- Denim in all forms is not allowed.
- As your child is already fully aware, tramlines in hair are not allowed, and will result in isolation.

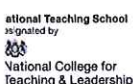
If you have any concerns about these aspects of our uniform policy, please contact your child's Learning Manager.
